Finders International have launched a new service across Ireland to assist county councils and members of the public who are aware of, or own, properties that have become abandoned or unused.


Our goal is to locate and talk to the legal owners of these properties, establish why their property is derelict or no longer in use and assist in any way

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The Housing Crisis in Ireland

Homelessness in Ireland is increasing year on year. Between December 2014 and December 2015 there was a net increase in the number of people recorded as homeless of 1,700 people, an increase of 43%.



How our service works:



1. Initial contact
